Specific Notice Regarding COVID-19

The novel coronavirus known as COVID-19 is a great concern for us all. In particular, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) states that based on currently available information and clinical expertise, older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions might be at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19. If you have any questions about whether you should participate in the Tournament, please contact an appropriate health care provider.

While the Tournament has undertaken a number of measures to help mitigate the risk transmission of COVID-19 and other contagious illnesses, elimination of risk of exposure and infection to COVID-19 is not currently possible. Should you choose to participate in the Tournament, you must follow all safety measures implemented by the Tournament with respect to COVID-19.

In particular, you may be required to do the following:

- Check your temperature before coming on site to ensure your temperature is below 100.4°
- Screen for symptoms of COVID-19, as identified by the CDC at <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html> on a regular basis;
- Submit to COVID-19 testing to the extent required by the Tournament;
- Maintain social distancing (staying at least 6 feet - about 2 arms' length - from other people) whenever possible;
- Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer that contains 60% alcohol including the hand sanitizer provided by the Tournament as often as possible;
- Wear personal protective equipment such as facemasks or masks that meet CDC guidelines, such as those that may be provided to you by the Tournament, in such circumstances when directed by the Tournament;
- Use sanitizing and disinfecting wipes provided by the Tournament as directed by the Tournament; and
- Limit activities when not at the tournament location to avoid unnecessary trips and unnecessary interactions with others not involved in the Tournament.

Further information about the requirements for each Tournament will be provided once volunteer assignments have been made.

I further understand and agree that if, in the judgment of the Korn Ferry Tour Tournament Director or his designee, adverse weather conditions or other occurrence or conditions beyond the control of the Host Organization or the Korn Ferry Tour renders commencement or continuance of the PRO-AM impractical then, in any such events, the PRO-AM may be delayed, postponed, shortened, or canceled, whichever may be deemed appropriate by the Korn Ferry Tour Tournament Director or his designee; and, the Host Organization shall have no obligation to refund any portion of the entry fee remitted herewith by reason of any such postponement, rescheduling or cancellation.

In consideration of Korn Ferry Tour services in co-sponsoring the Tournament, I (and, to the extent necessary the corporation listed above) hereby grant(s) and assign(s) to PGA TOUR, without limitation, my individual television, radio, motion picture, photographic, electronic, "Interactive Applications" (as defined below) and all other media rights with respect to my participation in the Tournament, PRO-AM or any other golf event conducted in conjunction with the Tournament (e.g. clinics, long-drive contests), or any portion thereof. "Interactive Applications" shall mean the presentation in any medium in a way that permits the viewer to interact with or manipulate the presentation or access other relevant information during the presentation. I agree to refrain from any action which will interfere with PGA TOUR's ownership of the rights hereunder granted and assigned to PGA TOUR or with any authorized use thereof. I also agree to abide by and be governed by the PGA TOUR Tournament Regulations currently in effect and by the Rules of Golf of the United States Golf Association, subject to any modifications thereof approved by PGA TOUR.

NOTE: During the Pro-Am, the Host Organization will provide at least two stations on each "nine" where players can obtain snacks, nutritional food, and non-alcoholic beverages. Players are asked not to bring any food and beverages.

Notice to Pro-Am Participants

From PGA TOUR RULES COMMITTEE

1. Maximum Amateur Score

Each team is requested to play at a reasonable pace, no slower than 15 minutes per hole, or four 1/2 hours for the round, and to keep up with the group in front of them. The amateur player with the lowest handicap is responsible for assisting the professional in monitoring the pace of play. Amateurs are asked to pick up if out of the hole.

2. Suspension of Play Procedures

The condition of competition adopted specifically for dangerous weather suspension is as follows:

When play is suspended for dangerous weather (i.e., lightning, tornado, high wind, etc.), if the players in a group are between the play of two holes, they shall not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If they are in the process of playing a hole, they shall discontinue play immediately and shall not thereafter resume play until the committee has ordered a resumption of play. **A suspension for dangerous weather shall be signaled by one prolonged siren or horn note.**

All other types of suspension for non-dangerous weather (i.e., darkness, casual water, fog, etc.) shall be signaled by several short intermittent siren or horn notes. If players are in the process of playing a hole, they may continue provided they do so without any delay. If they choose to continue, they shall discontinue either before or immediately after completing the hole.

Note: All practice areas shall be closed during suspension for dangerous weather until the Committee has declared them open for use.
