2026 tournament to serve as final event of the Korn Ferry Tour regular season

KANSAS CITY, Missouri — The AdventHealth Championship announced today the 2026 playing of the tournament will be nationally televised on Golf Channel, marking a significant milestone for the long-standing Korn Ferry Tour event. The announcement aligns with a multi-year extension with host venue Blue Hills Country Club, securing the tournament's home in south Kansas City through 2029.

The 2026 AdventHealth Championship will take place August 17-23, officially serving as the final regular season event on the Korn Ferry Tour calendar. Following the tournament, four Korn Ferry Tour Finals events will determine which 20 players on the Korn Ferry Tour Points List earn coveted PGA TOUR cards.

To watch these incredible athletes chase their PGA TOUR dreams right here in KC is something truly special.

The national telecast deal and venue extension also coincide with a renewed commitment from title sponsor AdventHealth, reinforcing the Championship's growing stature within professional golf.

Past champions of the AdventHealth Championship include Overland Park native Harry Higgs (2024), and PGA TOUR winners Grayson Murray (2023), Cameron Young (2021) and Sepp Straka (2018).
