AdventHealth Championship announces dates for 2023 tournament

Annual Korn Ferry Tour event set for May 15-21

Kansas City, Mo. – Tournament officials announced today the tournament date for the Korn Ferry Tour's 2023 AdventHealth Championship, set to be contested the week of May 15-21 at Blue Hills Country Club in Kansas City, Mo.

The AdventHealth Championship is a PGA TOUR-sanctioned event on the Korn Ferry Tour, conducted annually at Blue Hills Country Club in Kansas City, Mo. This tournament is four-day, 72-hole competition featuring 156 players from around the world vying for a total purse of \$1 million. The 2023 season will feature several changes recently announced by the Korn Ferry Tour including five additional TOUR cards (30 total) awarded to the top players on the KFT points list at season's end, increased purses, and 500 points to the winners.

As the path to the PGA TOUR, the Korn Ferry Tour features some of the most talented professional golfers who are ready to compete and win on golf's biggest stage. Currently the AdventHealth Championship's 2021 winner, Cameron Young, sits ninth in FedExCup rankings, has seven PGA TOUR top-10 finishes, and is in the running for the 2022 Rookie of the Year. The 2022 winner, Trevor Cone, earned his first-ever TOUR card at the season finale, finishing 22nd in the Korn Ferry Tour rankings.

As the only PGA-TOUR sanctioned event in the Kansas City area, the AdventHealth Championship is committed to the community, with the motto: It's More Than Golf. This is the tournament's commitment to deliver an unparalleled experience to fans, partners, volunteers, and TOUR players and positively impact the Kansas City community. In partnership with title sponsor AdventHealth, the Play It Forward Program recognizes and supports 10 local charities annually with a matching donations program made possible by the Cocherl Family Foundation. Last year more than \$70,000 was raised to help support local charities that focused on behavioral/mental wellbeing and substance abuse.
