· Once the wristband is removed, it will be considered invalid and cannot be replaced.

· Once the wristband is removed, it will be considered invalid and cannot be replaced.

Club FOREteen ticket holders please note:

- Club FOREteen ticket holders **MUST** receive a wristband at main entry before accessing their hospitality venue.
- Tickets will be scanned TWICE at the MAIN ENTRY TENT - one for tournament entrance, and a second time to receive your hospitality wristband. Both scans will occur at the main entry tent.
 - Once the wristband is removed, it will be considered invalid and cannot be replaced.
 - Club FOREteen wristbands only allow access to hospitality units on the 14th Green.
 - Club FOREteen guests can receive up to 3 complimentary drinks at the Fan Zone using their tabbed wristband.
- Youth Policy – All guests entering in hospitality venues must have a proper ticket unless they are under 12 years of age.

Member's Club ticket holders, please note:

- Member's Club ticket holders & guests **MUST** receive a wristband at main entry before accessing their hospitality venue.
- Tickets will be scanned TWICE at the MAIN ENTRY TENT - one for tournament entrance, and a second time to receive your hospitality wristband. Both scans will occur at the main entry tent.
 - Once the wristband is removed, it will be considered invalid and cannot be replaced.
 - Member's Club Hospitality Tickets do not allow access into Club FOREteen private hospitality located on the 14th green
 - Lunch is served from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the OneDigital Hospitality tent or the grill in Members Club tent
 - Only Members Club ticket holders receive complimentary beverages
 - Members Club ticket holders will have access to the Gibson Lounge from 10:00 am to end of play
 - Blue Hills members with members general admission tickets may enter the Gibson Lounge but must pay using member charge
- Youth Policy – All guests entering in hospitality venues must have a proper ticket unless they are under 12 years of age

ALL HOSPITALITY UNITS

There will be dedicated hospitality volunteers assigned to each hospitality venue. Volunteers will be responsible for the general operations of the hospitality area and will check the venues on a regular basis each day to make sure that you are satisfied. Shuttle Schedule

ON-COURSE SHUTTLES:

On-course shuttles will be available to assist guests to and from Hole 14 (Club FOREteen & BHCC Member's Club). Pick up/drop off locations will be located between Hole 10 tee & Hole 18 green and transport guests to Hole 15 Green. Hours of operation: 10am-6pm daily (Thursday-Sunday).

SPECTATOR GUIDE

The Spectator Guide will be available in digital format only and accessible through a QR code. This specific QR code will be displayed throughout the course and will include general tournament information as well as a course map and daily pairings guide. Tee times for Thursday and Friday are typically posted on our website 1-2 days before the tournament begins.

SECURITY:

Only those with the proper ticket, credential or wristband can gain access to tournament grounds. We encourage you to remove any items of value from cars and/or hospitality units. The tournament will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S)

Autograph Policy:

Autographs are permitted in Autograph Alley located near the grandstands on the 18th green.

Beverage Policy:

No alcoholic beverages may be served or sold to anyone under the age of 21 years. We reserve the right to refuse alcohol service to anyone unable to provide proper identification to verify age or anyone who appears intoxicated.

Dress Code:

It is suggested that guests dress comfortably for the conditions and the weather. Golf course casual is acceptable. Denim and t-shirts are strongly discouraged.

First Aid Stations:

Our first aid station will be located inside the Reserve Room nearest Hole 1 tee in the Blue Hills Clubhouse. In case of emergency, locate the nearest person with a radio or call 911.

Lost & Found:

All lost and found items will be turned into the Blue Hills CC Pro Shop, near Hole 1 tee. Blue Hills Country Club, the Korn Ferry Tour and the AdventHealth Championship are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Merchandise:

All tournament merchandise is available at the merchandise tent located behind the 10th tee box. All purchases must be made using credit card, no cash will be accepted.

No Cash:

The AdventHealth Championship is a cashless event, credit cards only.

Will Call:

There will be NO Will Call at the AdventHealth Championship. All tickets are mobile and can be shared via email. Tickets can either be printed at home or scanned on a mobile phone.

MOBILE PHONE POLICY:

Fans are allowed to take photos all week with their mobile devices throughout the golf course, except in areas of competition during official rounds or when requested by players, security, or Korn Ferry Tour officials to refrain from taking a photo.

Receiving or placing phone calls will remain limited to areas outside of play.

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage)
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week
- Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in the revocation of your ticket

WEATHER WARNING:

“Weather Warning” alerts will be on all scoreboards when inclement weather is detected within a dangerous range. The intent behind these alerts is to notify fans of potentially dangerous weather before play is suspended to give fans time to move back to their vehicles. All fans should take cover immediately once the “Weather Warning” alerts have been posted.

Suspension of play occurs with one prolonged blast of an air horn, repeated once. All fans should take cover immediately. Resumption of play occurs with two short blasts of an air horn, repeated once. Suspension of play is a stoppage of play, not necessarily a cancellation of play for the day.

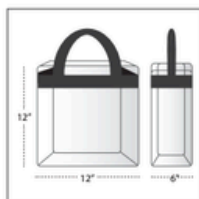

SECURITY & PROHIBITED ITEMS:

The AdventHealth Championship will ensure the safety of our spectators, players, volunteers, and guests by taking various security measures.

Any other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the Tournament Security Personnel is their sole discretion.

Parents with small children are allowed to bring strollers and diaper bags if needed. These items are subject to reasonable inspection before entering and/or at any time during the tournament.

PERMITTED ITEMS

	Clear plastic, vinyl or other carry items not exceeding 12"x 6"x12" (CLICK HERE for more information (http://www.pgatour.com/company/tournaments-prohibited-items.html#bagpolicy))
	A one gallon clear resealable plastic bag (CLICK HERE for more information (http://www.pgatour.com/company/tournaments-prohibited-items.html#bagpolicy))
	At the tournaments discretion, food may enter the tournament in a clear, resealable plastic bag, not to exceed the size of a one (1) gallon bag
	Mobile phones, tablets, and PDA's - MUST be on Silent mode and adhere to TOUR's Mobile Device Policy (CLICK HERE for more information (http://www.pgatour.com/company/mobile-device-policy.html))
	Point and shoot, film or DSLR cameras with lens smaller than 6"; no case (During Practice Rounds Only)
	Umbrellas without sleeve
	Portable radios with headsets
	Medically necessary materials, strollers, small diaper bags, plastic baby bottles, and other essential baby supplies (infant must be with carrier) - items subject to search
	Collapsible chairs without chair bags
	Binoculars without case
	Seat cushions that do not require a carrying case or that do not have pockets or compartments
	Segways®, motorized scooters or other personal transportation devices when used as a mobility aid by individuals with mobility impairment

PROHIBITED ITEMS



No bags larger than a small purse 6"x6" including carrying cases, backpacks, camera bags, or chair bags

No clear plastic, vinyl, or other carry items larger than 12"x6"x12"

No plastic, metal, glass cups, cans, or containers of any kind except for medical or infant needs



No computers or laptops



No fireworks or laser pointers



No lawn or over sized chairs



No seat cushions in a carrying case or that have pockets or compartments



No pets, except for service animals



No knives, firearms or weapons of any nature



No video cameras (All Week)



No point and shoot, film or DSLR cameras (During Competition Rounds)



No selfie sticks or hand held camera stabilizers



No beverages (patrons may not bring in or exit with beverages) or coolers



No radios, TVs, or portable speakers



No posters, signs or banners



No motorcycles, mopeds, tricycles, bicycles (whether or not motor-driven), skateboards, hoverboards, or other similar devices will be permitted to be operated on or within tournament property. Segways®, motorized scooters or other personal transportation devices are prohibited if not used as a mobility aid by individuals with mobility impairment
