General Admission Tickets - \$10

- Provide access to the tournament grounds. Public grandstands will be located on Hole 18 Green.

Grounds Pass - \$30

- Provide access to the tournament grounds. Public grandstands will be located on Hole 18 Green.

Tailgate Experience - \$85

- Provides access to shared greenside hospitality space on Hole 6 Green (behind the indoor hitting bay/first aid and next to the flagpole). Includes all-inclusive food, beverage, games & entertainment.

OneDigital Champions Club - \$225

- Provides access to the shared hospitality tent on Hole 18 green. Includes all-inclusive food and beverage (daily clubhouse lunch from 11:00am – 2:00pm), plus afternoon appetizers available in the tent daily from 2:00-5:00pm.

Tailgate Experience

Shared hospitality space located on the Hole 6 green. Includes food & drink, games, and entertainment. Lunch will be available from 11am-2pm.

Tailgate Experience ticket holders please note:

- Tailgate Experience ticket holders MUST receive a wristband at the main entry tent before accessing the hospitality venue.

- Tickets will be scanned TWICE at the MAIN ENTRY TENT - one for tournament entrance, and a second time to receive your hospitality wristband. Both scans will occur at the main entry tent.
- Wristbands will be checked and enforced prior to entering the clubhouse lunch.
- Once the wristband is removed, it will be considered invalid and cannot be replaced.

Shared hospitality space located on the 18th hole green. Includes food & full bar service. Lunch will be available from 11am-2pm daily in the upstairs of the Blue Hills CC Clubhouse. Afternoon appetizers available in the tent from 2-5pm daily.

Champions Club ticket holders please note:

- Champions Club ticket holders **MUST** receive a wristband at the main entry tent before accessing the hospitality venue.
- New in 2024: Tickets will be scanned TWICE at the MAIN ENTRY TENT - one for tournament entrance, and a second time to receive your hospitality wristband. Both scans will occur at the main entry tent.
- Please use the outside staircase by the Blue Clock to access the Clubhouse lunch.
- Wristbands will be checked and enforced prior to entering the clubhouse lunch.
- Once the wristband is removed, it will be considered invalid and cannot be replaced.
- Youth Policy – All guests entering in hospitality venues must have a proper ticket unless they are under 12 years of age.

Club FOREteen

Semi-private hospitality space located on the 14th hole green. Includes food & full bar service. Lunch will be available from 11am-2pm daily. Additional food requests must be made with Scratch Catering prior to the event.

Club FOREteen ticket holders please note:

- Club FOREteen ticket holders **MUST** receive a wristband before accessing their hospitality venue.
- New in 2024: Tickets will be scanned TWICE at the MAIN ENTRY TENT - one for tournament entrance, and a second time to receive your hospitality wristband. Both scans will occur at the main entry tent.
- Once the wristband is removed, it will be considered invalid and cannot be replaced.
- Club FOREteen wristbands only allow access to hospitality units on the 14th Green.
- Youth Policy – All guests entering in hospitality venues must have a proper ticket unless they are under 12 years of age.

- Member's Club ticket holders & guests **MUST** receive a wristband before accessing their hospitality venue.
- New in 2024: Tickets will be scanned TWICE at the MAIN ENTRY TENT - one for tournament entrance, and a second time to receive your hospitality wristband. Both scans will occur at the main entry tent.
- Once the wristband is removed, it will be considered invalid and cannot be replaced.
- BHCC Member's Club Hospitality Tickets do not allow access into Club Fourteen private hospitality located on the 14th green
- Youth Policy – All guests entering in hospitality venues must have a proper ticket unless they are under 12 years of age

ALL HOSPITALITY UNITS

There will be dedicated hospitality volunteers assigned to each hospitality venue. Volunteers will be responsible for the general operations of the hospitality area and will check the venues on a regular basis each day to make sure that you are satisfied. If problems arise, these volunteers will be your first resource for resolving the situation. Please find the nearest volunteer wearing a royal blue polo for assistance.

Shuttle Schedule

ON-COURSE SHUTTLES:

On-course shuttles will be available to assist guests to and from Hole 14 (Club FOREteen & BHCC Member's Club). Pick up/drop off locations will be located between Hole 10 tee & Hole 18 green and transport guests to Hole 15 Green. Hours of operation: 10am-6pm daily (Thursday-Sunday).

SPECTATOR GUIDES:

The Spectator Guide will be available in digital format only and accessible through a QR code. This specific QR code will be displayed throughout the course and will include general tournament information as well as a course map and daily pairings guide. Tee times for Thursday and Friday are typically posted on our website 1-2 days before the tournament begins. All AdventHealth Championship volunteers will also have the QR code for the Spectator Guide on the back of their tournament issued credential.

SIGNAGE:

There will be signage identifying each hospitality venue and directional signage to assist guests on their way to a desired location.

SECURITY:

Only those with the proper ticket, credential or wristband can gain access to tournament grounds. We encourage you to remove any items of value from cars and/or hospitality units. The tournament will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S)

Autograph Policy:

Autographs are permitted in Autograph Alley located outside the players locker room on the southeast side of the clubhouse.

Beverage Policy:

No alcoholic beverages may be served or sold to anyone under the age of 21 years. We reserve the right to refuse alcohol service to anyone unable to provide proper identification to verify age or anyone who appears intoxicated.

Disability Services:

If you need additional assistance accessing the tournament grounds, please contact the tournament office at 816-214-5087.

DRESS CODE:

It is suggested that guests dress comfortably for the conditions and the weather. Golf course casual is acceptable. Denim and t-shirts are strongly discouraged.

First Aid Stations:

Our first aid station will be located inside the Outdoor Hitting Bay, located next to the Driving Range. In case of emergency, locate the nearest person with a radio or call 911.

Lost & Found:

All lost and found items will be turned into the OneDigital Information Tent, located outside the Blue Hills CC Pro Shop, near Hole 1 tee. Items found in the hospitality units will be turned in to the Information Tent at the end of each day. Blue Hills Country Club, the Korn Ferry Tour and the AdventHealth Championship are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Merchandise:

All tournament merchandise is available at the information tent located outside the Blue Hills Country Club Pro Shop located next to the OneDigital Main Entry. All purchases must be made using credit card, no cash will be accepted.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

No Cash:

The AdventHealth Championship is a cashless event, credit cards only.

WILL CALL:

There will be **NO** Will Call at the AdventHealth Championship. All tickets are mobile and can be shared via email. Tickets can either be printed at home or scanned on a mobile phone.

MOBILE PHONE POLICY:

Fans are allowed to take photos all week with their mobile devices throughout the golf course, except in areas of competition during official rounds or when requested by players, security, or Korn Ferry Tour officials to refrain from taking a photo.

Receiving or placing phone calls will remain limited to areas outside of play.

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage)
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week
- Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in the revocation of your ticket

WEATHER WARNING:

“Weather Warning” alerts will be on all scoreboards when inclement weather is detected within a dangerous range. The intent behind these alerts is to notify fans of potentially dangerous weather before play is suspended to give fans time to move back to their vehicles. All fans should take cover immediately once the “Weather Warning” alerts have been posted.

Suspension of play occurs with one prolonged blast of an air horn, repeated once. All fans should take cover immediately. Resumption of play occurs with two short blasts of an air horn, repeated once. Suspension of play is a stoppage of play, not necessarily a cancellation of play for the day.

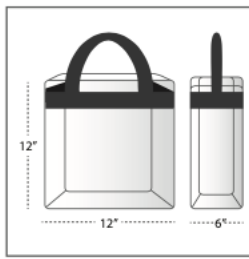

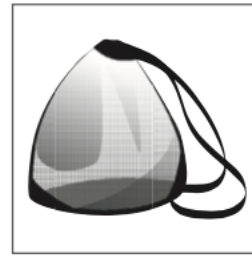

SECURITY & PROHIBITED ITEMS:

The AdventHealth Championship will ensure the safety of our spectators, players, volunteers, and guests by taking various security measures.

Any other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the Tournament Security Personnel is their sole discretion. Parents with small children are allowed to bring strollers and diaper bags if needed. These items are subject to reasonable inspection before entering and/or at any time during the tournament.
